Course 'Catalysis for Sustainability' Amsterdam, 5-6 October 2010

As part of the education activities of NIOK / CatchBio a two day course on "Catalysis for sustainability" takes place on **5 and 6 October 2010** in Amsterdam, preceding the CatchBio [symposium of 7 October](#) in Amsterdam. This course is targeted at PhD and postdoc researchers from Academic and Industrial laboratories, and will address various issues related to the need for sustainability for the future. The course will consist of lectures by specialists on various issues that are relevant to sustainability such as (i) Current refinery and petrochemicals industrial practices and related environmental issues, (ii) Biomass related feed stocks, availability, life cycle analysis and economic aspects (iii) Fundamental and applied aspects of the conversion of sustainable feed-stocks to fuels, bulk and fine chemicals.
